**St. Augustine's Priory:** We have an IGR Retreat next week and although the daily Masses will be in the evening the Priest facilitating the Retreat has kindly agreed to opening it to our Faith Communities. **Eucharistic Congress - 7 to 9 September 2018, Liverpool.** On Friday 7th September, there will be a Theological Symposium, with workshops for parish catechists, (especially for those involved in First Holy Communion programs), RE teachers, Hospital and Prison Chaplains, Seminary Communities and Extraordinary Ministers. The day runs from 10.00am to 6.00pm. Numbers for this are limited so places need to be booked when the booking process opens. On Saturday 8th September, there will be a six hour stage led event with two key note speakers, various presentations with music, drama, prayer and adoration. This day is open to all and 10,000 people are expected. On Sunday 9th September the Congress Masses will be celebrated at Liverpool Metropolitan Cathedral followed by an outdoor procession. The numbers for the Cathedral will be limited so these also require booking. Congress Themes: 1. Eucharist 2. Adoration 3. Scripture 4. Ecclesiology – the Church 5. Formation 6. Music 7.
