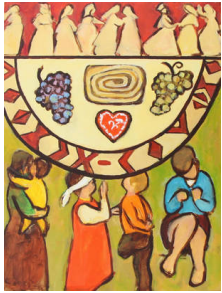

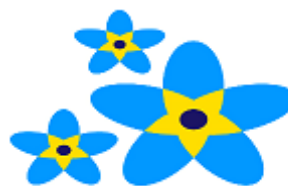
Prayer for the Parish
