Our surfacing contractor, J R Roberts of Holywell, has substantially completed resurfacing of the paved areas within the church grounds. There are a couple of things to be addressed and these will be undertaken shortly. Potholes have gone and the unevenness of some of the area has been largely removed. The surfacing is applied to prevent further, natural and abrasive wear and tear of a much deteriorated surface and should last for a few years before further treatment is needed. What you'll notice over the next few days is that the surface will lose some of its small stones and these will be loose on the surface - this is an entirely natural process and the contractor will return in about a fortnight's time to remove these small stones. It took longer than expected to carry out the works due to supply shortages, cold weather, contractor illness and our own services (Mass and funerals). I know it's been a little inconvenient at times over the last fortnight but wish to thank you all for your understanding and patience during the course of these works. Fr Frank.
