A reminder to those attending Mass -

Parishioners are reminded to follow the instructions and guidance of the Stewards

- *to wear face coverings properly (covering both mouth and nose) throughout the Mass,
- *to sanitise hands on entry to the church,
- *follow the one-way arrows,
- *maintain the correct social distancing for yourself/your family group,
- *to leave the church immediately following communion at the end of Mass (please, don't go back to your seat, take everything you brought with you up to communion, and reverently leave in silence with the presence of the Eucharist within us);

Please avoid congregating within the church grounds for a chat after Mass but leave these, too, straight away, following the arrows marked on the tarmac.

COVID 19 - STEWARDS IN THE CHURCH

I think we can take great pride in how most of our churches, and especially we here in St Joseph's, have responded to and complied with Government guidelines for social distancing, enabling us to gather and celebrate Mass. Adherence to those guidelines has given much confidence to Parishioners to enable them to safely return to Mass.
