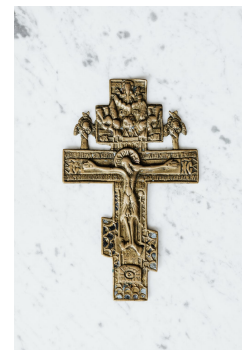

Synodality update:

Over the last few months our Diocese, alongside all Dioceses in England and Wales, undertook the Synodality survey/questionnaire about the state of the Catholic Church, the practice of our faith and our hopes for the future of the universal church.

Our Parish responses were forwarded a few weeks ago to the Wrexham Diocese Synodality Team (under the leadership of Fr Ian Dalgleish of Bleanau Ffestiniog) for amalgamation with the responses of other Parishes. The amalgamated (synthesised) draft of the Diocesan responses was presented to Bishop Peter for his review and approval in early April. The final Wrexham document was forwarded by Bishop Peter to the Bishop's Conference of England and Wales in early April 2022. Bishop Peter has yet to authorise publication of the Wrexham document and it is anticipated that this could be made available on the internet as many other Dioceses have so far done.

A National Synthesis Team reviewed all the submissions from across England and Wales and developed a 20 page summary document, the Draft National Synthesis. On Wednesday, 1st June 2022 a meeting of Bishops, Diocesan Team Leaders and Lay representatives met at Southwark Cathedral in London to review the draft document.

The National Synthesis Team will now present a second draft of the national synthesis to a Plenary Assembly of the Bishops' Conference for its consideration.

Following this meeting, to be held on 28 June 2022 in Westminster, a final draft will be presented to the Bishops for their assent for submission to the Synod Office in Rome by the 15 August 2022.

A Continental Phase then follows, between September 2022 -March 2023, that involves the task of discussing the text of the first Instrumentum Laboris from a European perspective.

The process then moves on to the Synod of Bishops (Rome) in October 2023 where finally, the synodal journey will culminate with the celebration of the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops on the theme "For a synodal Church: communion, participation and mission".
