You may already be aware but there is a tour of England, Scotland and Wales of the **Relics of St. Bernadette in September and October this year.**

It is confirmed that this tour will come to Wrexham Diocese as follows :

- ★ The Cathedral Church of our Lady of Sorrows, Wrexham at 2.30pm on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> September to 9am on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2022.
- ★ St Winefrides Well Shrine, Holywell on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2022 between 9.45am and 4.30pm

It is envisaged that Volunteers will be required, and a rota will be devised as there will need to be two or three persons in the church to safeguard the relics at any one time.
