JPIC Nature Walk 4th June 2025 at 5pm



We're having a nature walk to the top of Bryn Euryn here in Colwyn Bay. Starting from the church, we walk to the start of this Local Nature Reserve and then walk along woodland and grassy paths and tracks to the summit of Bryn Euryn.

The walk is graded 'easy to moderate' by Conwy County Borough Council in its brochure about the nature reserve. This waymarked circular trail leads you past the ruined mansion of Llys Euryn, through woodland and grassland, to the ancient hillfort at the summit, with its panoramic views, and bird's eye view of Colwyn Bay

The trail is about a mile in length and has some steep climbs/descents which can be slippery after rain, so you will need stout footwear. If you'd be interested in coming along, please give your details on the sign-up sheet on the notice-board at the back of church.
