We ask parishioners to bring food to share for the celebration. A sign-up sheet will be available at the back of the church to help us plan a variety of dishes.
- Jubilee Exhibition The church will host a special exhibition telling the story of the past, present and future of our parish through photographs and treasured items. We invite you to share your memories and stories, to help us to honour our past and pass it on to the next generation. Please bring photographs, memorabilia, or items of parish life to the Presbytery by Sunday 21st September, clearly labelled with; your name, contact details, a brief description (e.g. names, event) and the approximate date. These will be displayed in our Jubilee Exhibition and safely returned afterwards.
- In line with the Church's Jubilee of Hope and its theme "Pilgrims of Hope", we invite parishioners to express and share their hopes and dreams for the future of our parish through art, poetry, or any creative form. These contributions will be displayed alongside memories of the

past, reminding us that our story is still unfolding.

Children's Jubilee Displays – Creative displays from each school year group will be displayed in the School Hall during the Parish Celebration, reminding us of the hope and

promise of the future. Other Jubilee Events - In the coming months, there will be more opportunities for fellowship and fun.
