During Lent, Stations of the Cross will be held every Saturday at 10am, and also on Good Friday.

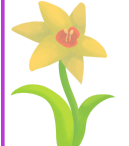
All are warmly invited to join us as different parish groups lead us in prayer and reflection on the Passion of the Lord.
